ABOUT RAJIV GANDHI UNIVERSITY

Rajiv Gandhi University, previously known as Arunachal University, stands as the leading institution for higher education in Arunachal Pradesh and has recently celebrated its twenty five years of establishment. The foundation stone of the university was laid by the late Smt. Indira Gandhi, who was the Prime Minister of India at the time, on 4 th February 1984 at Rono Hills, the site of the current campus. Since its founding, the university has consistently pursued excellence and aimed to fulfil the objectives outlined in the University Act. It received academic recognition under section 2(f) from the University Grants Commission on 28 th March 1985 and commenced operations on 1 st April 1985. Financial recognition under section 12-B of the UGC was granted on 25 th March 1994. Following this, Rajiv Gandhi University, formerly Arunachal University, established itself as a significant player in the educational landscape of India, having been designated as a University with potential for excellence by a distinguished expert committee from the University Grants Commission. The institution was officially designated as Central University on 9 th April 2007, in accordance with a notification from the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India. The University is situated atop Rono Hills, encompassing a scenic tableland of 302 acres that overlooks the Dikrong River. It is positioned 6.5 kilometres from National Highway 415 and 25 kilometres from, Itanagar, the capital of the State. Access to the campus is facilitated by the Dikrong bridge, which connects it to the National Highways.

The University's teaching and research initiatives are structured to contribute positively to the socio-economic and cultural advancement of the State. It provides a range of educational offerings, including certificate Course, Diplomas, Post Graduate Diplomas, Undergraduate, Post-Graduate, and Ph.D. programs. There are in total 13 faculties – Basic Science, Commerce Management, Communication Studies, Education, Environmental Science, Engineering and Technology, Language, Life Science, Social Science, Law, Physical Education and Sport Science Agricultural Science and Library & Information Science. There are 45 affiliated collages under the University's jurisdiction. The institution has been providing educational opportunities to students from neighbouring State, especially Assam, and the enrolment in various Departments and affiliated colleges has been consistently on the rise. Faculty members have been deeply involved in research initiatives, receiving financial backing from the UGC and other funding organizations. Since its establishment, the University has received approval for numerous research project proposals from various funding bodies.

The Library Professionals Association (LPA) is a registered non-profit society under The Society Registration Act of 1860, dedicated to supporting and developing library and information science (LIS) professionals in Bharat. LPA aims to enhance the LIS profession through various initiatives, including organising seminars, conferences, training courses, and workshops focused on emerging information technologies.

Since 2012, LPA has hosted its annual conference, "Knowledge Organization in Academic Libraries" (KOAL), exploring different themes each year at esteemed institutions. The conference has evolved to include international perspectives, starting with the first International Conference on Knowledge Organisation in Academic Libraries (I-KOAL) in 2015 at Manipal University, Jaipur, which was met with great success. Subsequent I-KOAL events have been held at various universities across India, including Goa University, University of Hyderabad, and Sardar Patel University.

In response to the challenges posed by the pandemic, LPA organised over 25 webinars for LIS professionals, reaching approximately 50,000 individuals worldwide. Finally after pandemic I-KOAL 2022 held at Tumkur University-Karnataka, I-KOAL 2023 at C-DAC, Navi Mumbai, in 2024 we did in MIT-WPU, Pune and I-KOAL 2025 we successfully conducted with DDU Gorakhpur University. This adaptability has underscored LPA's commitment to continuous learning and professional development within the library community.

Doimukh: which is 25 km from Itanagar is situated on the left bank of river Pare and can be seen from the capital complex. The Rajiv Gandhi University is situated atop a hill called Rono Hill. Sangram is a beautiful hill station. River Paging, which is a tributary of Kurung River flows through this natural scenic landscape. The location of this place and its rural landscape is ideal for nature lovers and adventure seekers.

Sagalee: is 112 km from Itanagar and is a sub-divisional headquarters. It is situated in a beautiful valley with eye catching natural landscape.
